



<p>Literacy Fiction: We will be planning and writing short narratives. The focus for our literacy work will be to acquire and use effective vocabulary in our writing, to use a range of sentence structures and mark these using the appropriate punctuation.</p>
<p>Maths: In maths we will revise and develop our understanding of number and place value. We will continue to develop and use calculation strategies for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will learn about measurement and apply our learning in a range of contexts. We will use our mathematical skills, logic and reasoning to solve problems and undertake investigations.</p>
<p>Science: In science, we will be exploring sound, developing our understanding of how the ear works and looking at ways in which sound can be changed. We will be learning about electricity - we will be making simple circuits from circuit diagrams and develop our understanding of how switches work. We will carry out investigation work about what happens when components within a circuit are changed.</p>
<p>ICT: We will revise e-safety and explore how to use the internet safely to research information. We will be using our ICT skills to enhance other areas of the curriculum such as Geography and Science.</p>
<p>Geography: We will be revising and developing our mapping skills. We will be focussing on places in Europe exploring weather, climate and what makes them a tourist destination.</p>
<p>P.E. In P.E. we will be working on improving our skills in different areas of athletics, trying to improve our own personal bests as well as competing against one another. We will also be developing skills in ball games, learning the rules of different games and playing in small teams against each other.</p>
<p>R.E. Year 3: Remembering - we will be exploring different religious festivals and thinking about how these help people remember. Year 4: Belief in the Community - we will be exploring different faith communities and thinking about how they are similar and different.</p>
<p>P.H.S.C.E. We will be exploring the importance of Mutual Respect and Democracy. Keeping healthy: We will be continuing to develop the children's understanding of the importance of maintaining a healthy lifestyle, including what we eat and the physical activity we take part in.</p>
<p>French: In languages, we will be learning basic words and phrases in French.</p>
<p>Music: In music, we have a music specialist who will be developing skills in all areas throughout the year.</p>
<p>Art and Design: Our Art and Design work will be linked to the upcoming Hull City of Culture!</p>
