

**Literacy:**

Fiction - We will be exploring a range of science fiction texts before developing our own ideas to help us plan and write our own Science Fiction texts!

Non-fiction - We will be exploring the art of persuasion in a range of texts, including visual texts. Using different persuasive techniques, we will design and produce our own persuasive texts.

Maths:

In maths we will focus on developing children's calculation skills further and using these to solve a range of problems. Skills will be developed in all areas including shape, fractions, measure and data handling. Children will have the opportunity to develop their reasoning skills and develop logical thinking.

Science:

In science, we will be looking at ways in which animals and plants can be classified. We will develop our investigative skills through work linked with how our bodies react when we increase physical activity.

ICT:

We will develop our Word processing skills with the aim of increasing the pace at which we can type as well as the accuracy. We will recap on formatting text, including alignment and spacing.

Geography: In Geography, we will focus on the United Kingdom and recap basic geographical knowledge. Using the local area, we will develop mapping and orientation skills. Going further afield, we will explore the composition of the United Kingdom, identifying urban and rural areas, major rivers, National Parks and mountain ranges. We will reflect on geographical changes that have occurred over time.

In P.E. we will be developing skills which we can apply to a range of invasion games. We will also be developing skills in athletics, which the children will be able to apply during our sports' week and sp
