

Year 5&6 Curriculum Map Summer 2017

Life As We Know it

Important: Year 6 SATS week beginning Monday 8th May 2017

Literacy:

Year 6: Y6 are reading *The Boy in the Striped Pyjamas* by John Boyne.

Year 5: Y5 are reading 'Cosmic' by Frank Cottrell-Boyce.

Across the phase, they will be continuing to develop higher order reading skills and writing letters, descriptions and advertisements. We will be having a big focus on punctuation across the whole phase.

Maths:

In Maths we will be continuing to study fractions, decimals and percentages. We will also be working on shape and measures, with a particular focus on angles.

Science:

This term's work is focused on life processes. Children will learn more about the life cycles of mammals and how these compare to the life cycles of other creatures such as birds and amphibians. They will also build on their understanding of plant life cycles and do some planting and dissection.

ICT:

In ICT, we will be researching the life of Charles Darwin and create a biographical recount from this.

Geography:

Children will build on their knowledge of U.K. cities and regions. They will develop their mapping skills through a study of the local area, and will build on their understanding of land use.

P.E.

As usual, we place great importance on promoting health and fitness. In their dedicated P.E. lessons, children will be working with Mr Jones on a combination of units including striking and fielding followed by athletics. In addition to this, children will also benefit from a range of physical activities provided at playtimes and lunch times. We will continue to provide a broad range of after school sports clubs throughout the Summer term.

R.E.

We continue to work from the locally agreed syllabus for R.E. Our Year 5 pupils will be learning about pilgrimage whilst the Year 6 children will be concentrating on a unit called 'Justice and Freedom'.

P.H.S.C.E.

We will be concentrating on healthy relationships during our Healthy Lifestyles Week. During the summer term, Year 6 pupils will take part in a sex education session delivered by the school nursing team and for Year 5 pupils, this will include a 'Growing up' session. We will also continue to work on how to understand and manage our emotions. Year 6 pupils will be completing a number of sessions linked to their transition to secondary school.

French:

We will be developing our speaking, listening, reading and writing skills through a range of activities linked to food. Bon Appetit!

Music:

Y5 will be taking part in the City of Culture project 'A Song for Hull'. Y6 children will be using their music sessions to work towards the summer Production.

Art and Design:

This term we will be focusing on developing our skills in observational drawing. Through our science work, we will be sketching a range of flowers and plants. Year 5 and 6 pupils will be visiting Ferens Art Gallery to take part in art workshops throughout the day. Linked to the City of Culture theme - 'Freedom', we will be focussing on artists and artwork that encompass this theme.

Design and Technology:

In line with Healthy Lifestyles Week, we will be looking at designing and making a range of healthy eating options.
