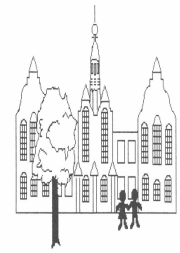

Clubs Restart

Our after school clubs restart this week. Please sign the attached consent form for the clubs of your choice. We also have a new club this year. *The Fantastic Food* cookery club will start on Thursday 18th September 3.15pm-4.15pm and will run for six weeks. Children who attend this club will be involved in a range of tasting and cooking activities and will be asked to contribute £5 each to cover the cost of resources for the six week period. Places are limited to six children per session and a new group of children will be selected each half term. Places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis and a waiting list will be created for future half terms. Parent consent slips will need to be returned to Mrs Heidstra and Mrs Bielby as soon as possible if your child wishes to attend this club.
