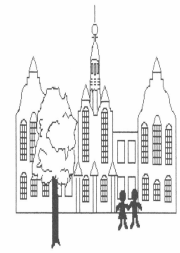

Oskar Meets the Queen

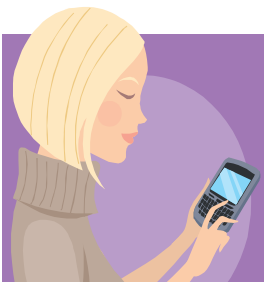
As we reported last week Oskar made a great impression on the Queen and the Lord Mayor last week at the Guildhall Civic Luncheon that he and Mr Browning attended.
