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TURNING OUT FOR SCHOOL!

We encourage all pupils to wear school uniform. We feel this gives them a clear sense of identity and reinforces our strong learning community. We would ask parents/carers of all our pupils to make every effort to support the school in this area.

Pupils are asked to wear a school uniform which consists of: a red school sweatshirt (available in a variety of sizes from the office for £7); a white polo shirt, shirt or blouse; black or navy trousers/skirt/pinafore dress.

Summer uniform for girls – red & white gingham or striped dresses.

For safety reasons girls shoes must be flat-heeled.

We also request that children bring a change of kit for PE i.e. a T shirt and shorts. We do, at times, ask that children bring a suitable outdoor PE kit and trainers.

In the interests of health and safety for themselves and others children should not wear jewellery for school. Watches are permissible but must be removed for P.E. If earrings are worn they should be studs and must be removed for P.E.

SAFETY AND STRANGER DANGER!

On Monday PCSO Lana Walsham

spoke to all the children about the importance of not talking to strangers. Many of our children enjoy playing out and using local facilities, such as Sculcoates Park. Help your children by reinforcing this message.

In the summer term, Lana, who is also one of school governors, will be running the Super Police Kids scheme again. We were used as the pilot school for this and since she started it, Lana is now expanding it across the city. This gives pupils an awareness of local community issues.
