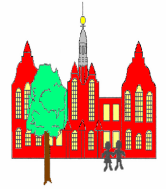

This week, years 4 and 5 have been out on patrol. Donning high-visibility vests, and armed with clipboards and junior police notebooks, the children were taken on a walk around the neighbourhood. Whilst on patrol they assisted in locating some missing (stolen) items in Pearson Park and spotting a suspected shop lifter. Two PCSOs have led each class and provided a wealth of other information about how the local police work to support and protect the community.

Looking after the Outdoor Classroom

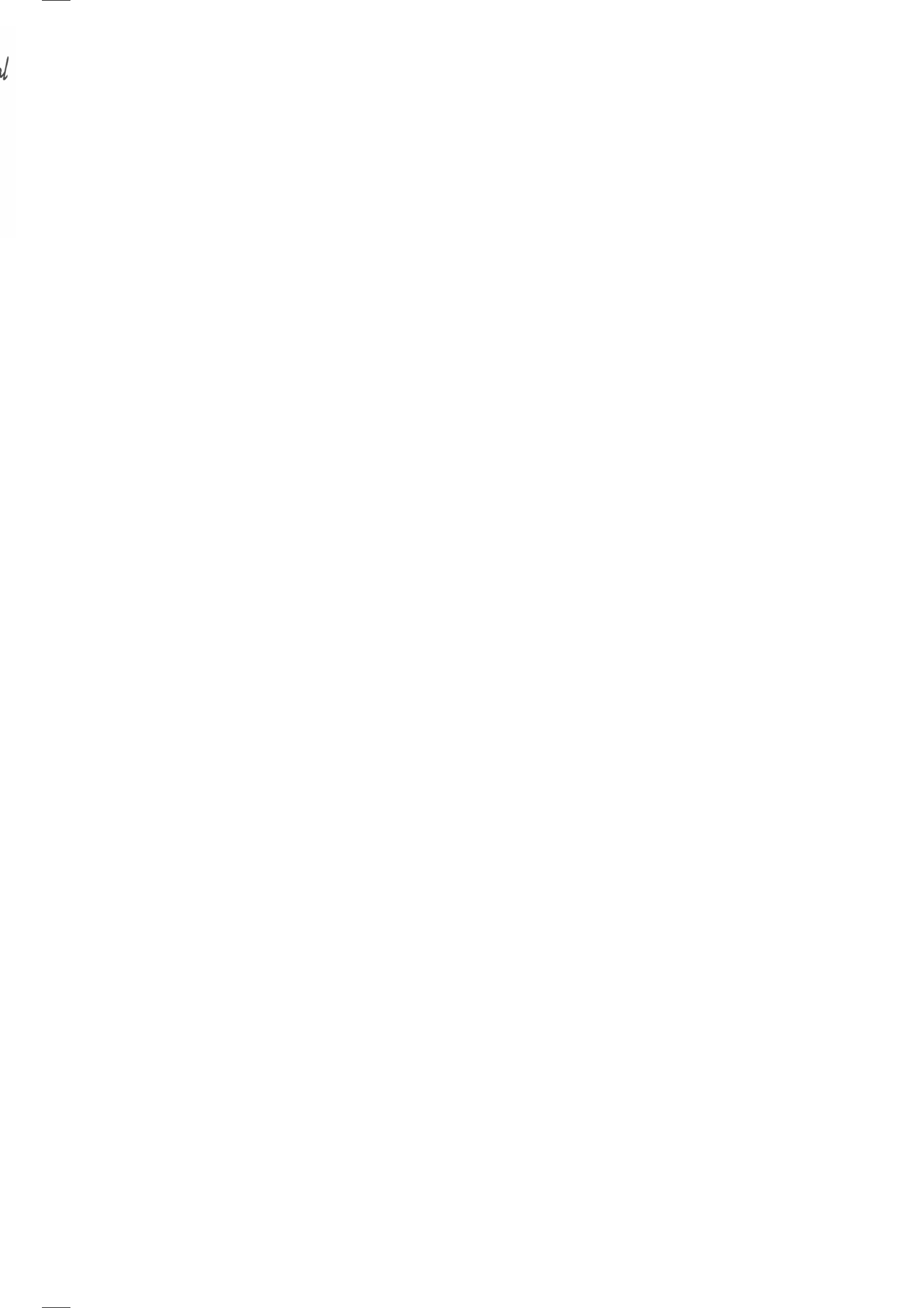
