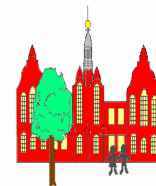

## **NEW PE KIT**

Following the positive response we have had from parents and carers with regard to our whole school uniform drive, we have also been listening to comments and suggestions about PE kits. From September 2011, pupils will need to have a specific PE kit. We've kept it really simple so it can be easily purchased and cheap. Boys and girls will need to wear a plain white T shirt and red shorts. They will also need to bring a change of footwear: either sandshoes or trainers. Pupils **will not** be allowed to turn up for PE wearing shoes, boots or sandals. PE kit can be purchased cheaply from shops, such as Tesco or Boyes, or from our school office. We are selling a kit of white T shirt and red shorts in a PE kit bag for £7. If you would like to order one then please complete the order form slip that will be coming home with your child. 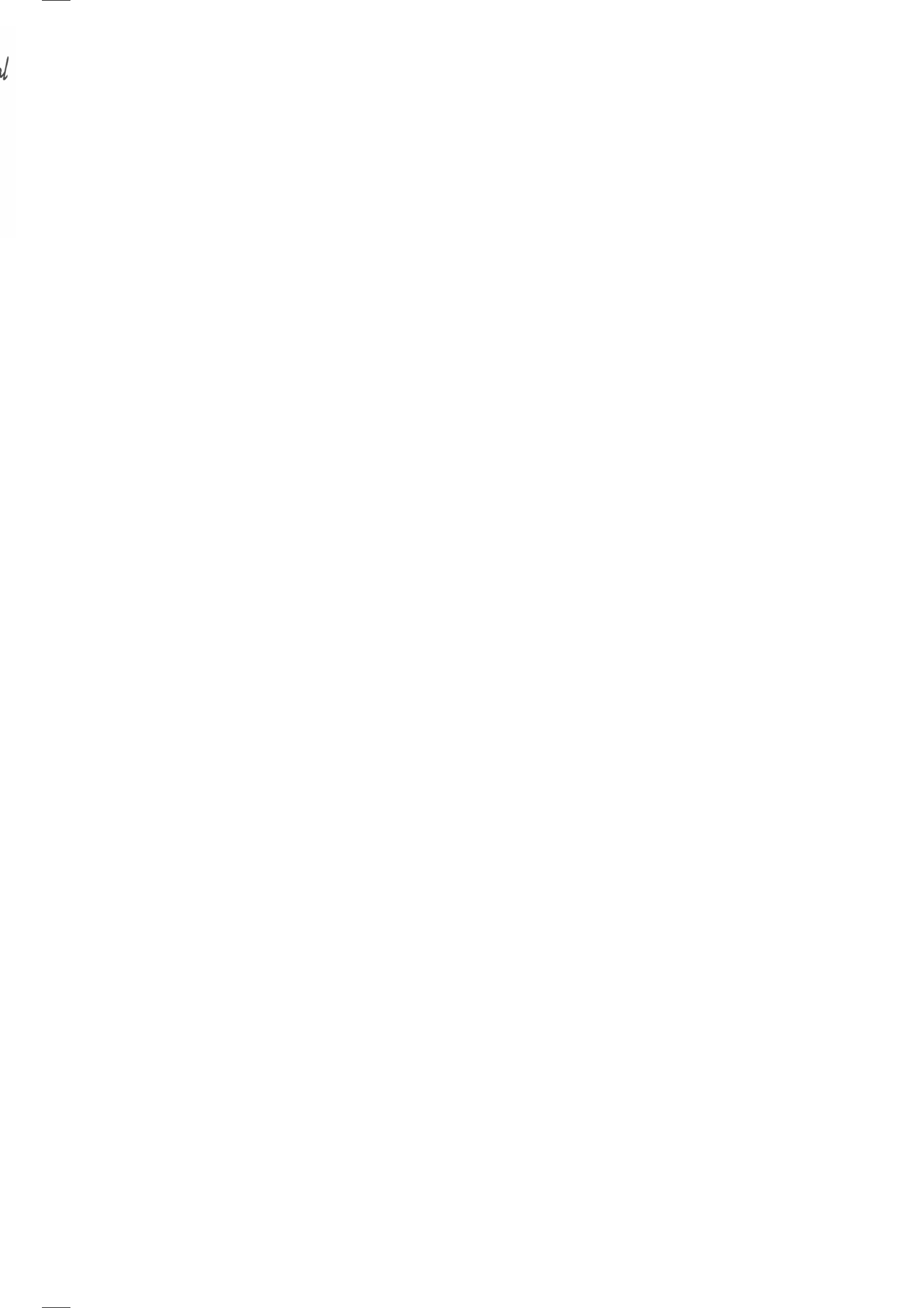
## **Commemorative 125 Photo**
