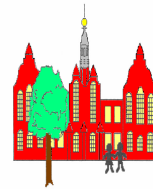

The following is a list of minor ailments that parents can get free treatment for from your local pharmacy. If the child receives free health treatment then they will not pay for the item. If parents/carers take their child's NHS number (on their NHS medical card) to a pharmacy, then they can get the free treatment and medication. Many thanks to the parent who brought this to our attention, and to our school nurse, Mrs Metcalfe, who has provided us with the following list that this scheme covers:
