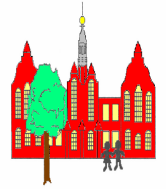

On Monday, our year 5 pupils experienced a rather soggy visit to Warter. This is a small village to the east of Pocklington and the site of an Augustine Priory, which was dissolved by King Henry VIII in 1536. Our pupils were being led by staff from Hull

Children's University to sketch different sites around the village and experience what it is like to live in a small rural community, compared with a city.
