visited the Houses of Parliament. This visit included a virtual tour of the House of Lords plus sitting and watching a live debate in the House of Commons. Our pupils learned how British Democracy works and the history about it. They learned the principles behind our British Values and marvelled at the architecture and scale of the Palace of Westminster.

A workshop followed in which the pupils learned how we shape Laws in Britain and how they are passed through Parliament. The party then walked through St. James Park to look at Buckingham Palace and back up through Horse Guards Parade to see the changing of the mounted guards. A quick stop at the gates into Downing Street and a chat with the friendly policemen there, before an enjoyable trip on the London Eye, with the breath-taking views over London. Once off this attraction, the party popped into watch the London Eye 4D experience before heading back home. Our profound thanks go to Mick and his team from Hull Children's University. Everything went like clockwork and a great day was had by all!
