A workshop followed in which the pupils learned how we shape Laws in Britain and how they are passed through Parliament. The party then walked through St. James Park to look at Buckingham Palace and back up through Horse Guards Parade to see the changing of the mounted guards. A quick stop at the gates into Downing Street and a chat with the friendly policemen there, before an enjoyable trip on the London Eye, with the breath-taking views over London.
