The SATs exams for our year 6 pupils begin next Monday on 8th May. Tests will be carried out during the morning and it is essential that children arrive promptly at school. These tests are a government requirement therefore all children must complete them. The timetable of tests is:

In a recent MOCK SATs test, we used the school hall, instead of the classroom and found this to be more conducive for the test environment so we are repeating it for the real thing. No access to the hall will be allowed during the exam times.

Please will parents ensure their children are ready for the exams every morning. If there are any problems, such as sickness, we urge year 6 parents to get in touch with the school as soon as possible so we may start considering alternative arrangements.
