The End of SATs 17'

All the months of preparation and revision have finally come to an end! Pupils finished their SATs exam timetable with one final maths 'reasoning' paper on Thursday. There were audible sighs of relief by all, as our pupils then enjoyed a thoroughly-deserved extra long playtime in glorious sunshine. Well done to all our pupils this year. Everyone was present at school and on time for all the papers and certainly did their very best. We are very proud of the way they have conducted themselves this week.

A Red Letter Day - Cutting the Statues & Media Coverage

On Monday and Tuesday Mr Browning and Mr Cameron took twelve KS2 pupils to W Campbell and Son to see the first of our Station Sculptures being cut using the large industrial laser cutting machine. While the rest of the factory was shut down for the lunch break, our pupils watched as this one specialised machine, was kept on to cut our designs out. The MD, Brian Campbell, met us at the factory and first showed the pupils printouts of the design spec. This came from the computer that controls the laser cutter. We then went into the factory to see this huge machine about to start work on a large sheet of mild steel. First, the laser scanned the sheet to calibrate itself and then it started to work. An intense beam of laser cut through the steel as easily as a knife through butter. Brian explained that it was so hot that the laser vapourised the metal! It quickly got to work! In no time at all the first of our sculptures had been cut out - this was the mother figure. Brian and one of his workmen lifted the figure down to show us. On Monday, James Piekos from BBC Radio Humber-side interviewed us all, plus there was a reporter/cameraman from Estuary TV to record the event. These were broadcast on Tuesday. Mr Cameron's visit had Kofi and his BBC Look North team join them.
