be reading the text, Kensuke's Kingdom and will develop our comprehension skills by using evidence from the text to support our predictions, opinions and answers.

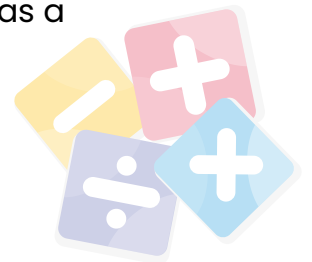


As writers, we will...

continue our work on short multiplication and division before moving on to area and scaling. while developing our skills to explain what area is and how measuring area can be used as a counting strategy.

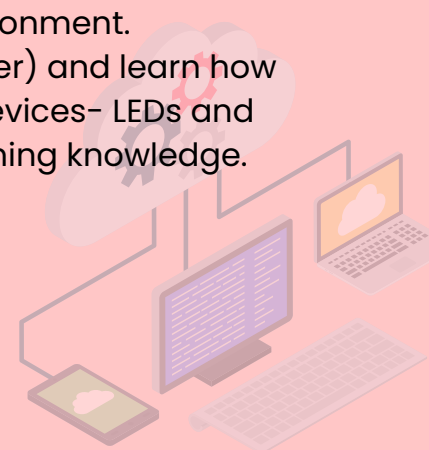
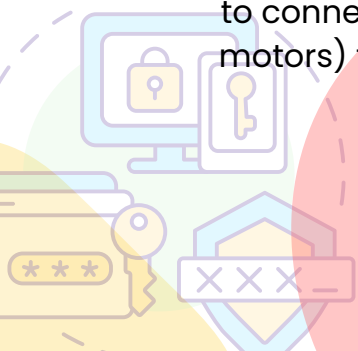


As scientists, we will...
